In 1945, Owens Corning Fiberglas created the Fiberglas Huntingdon Federal Credit Union solely for the benefit of their employees. In June 1995, the Fiberglas Credit Union moved out of the Owens Corning plant to the 1211 Washington St. location. In 2001, the name changed to the Huntingdon Co.
